The parade is scheduled to begin at 1pm at Boyd Elementary School and will travel down Knox Avenue to Cemetery Road to Boyd High School. The Homecoming Pep-Rally will be held right after the parade in the new Boyd High School Gymnasium. All Boyd Cheerleading squads 1st grade through HS will perform at the pep-rally. BES students will be bused to the high school and watch the parade as it arrives at BHS.
