Taylor Rawlings and Sarah Smith of the Boyd FFA Chapter were awarded the Lone Star FFA Degree at the 82nd annual Texas FFA Convention held in Corpus Christi on July 13-16. The Lone Star FFA Degree is the highest degree bestowed by the Texas FFA.

The Lone Star FFA Degree recognizes FFA members who have received the Chapter degree, been active FFA members for at least two years, completed at least four semesters of agricultural science at or above the ninth grade level, maintained a supervised agricultural experience (SAE) program, demonstrated their leadership skills and have shown a commitment to the FFA through involvement at the chapter level and above. Taylor and Sarah represent two out of more than 1,400 FFA members receiving this esteemed degree.
