We have 19 exhibitors showing over the next 3 weeks at the 115th annual Ft. Worth Stock Show. Our students heifers, steers, goats, lambs will be competing against over 5000 students from across the state.

On Monday, several BISD students spent their day off from school in Fort Worth at the Stock Show. Madelaine Pack, Sarah Murray and Garrett Woodruff exhibited Nubians in the Dairy Goat division and Tanner Hudson represented Boyd FFA in the Youth Longhorn Show this past weekend. In the dairy show, Madelaine exhibited 9 goats and received an impressive three 1st place ribbons, two 2nd place awards, 3rd in the Sr. Division Costume Contest, and a Reserve Champion in the Sr. Doe division. Garrett Woodruff received 2nd place in the Jr. Division Costume Contest and Sarah Murray received 8th place with her Nubian doe.

In the Youth Longhorn Show, Tanner Hudson also had a busy day showing five Longhorns. He received 3rd place, two 4th place ribbons, 9th place, and 13th place. More than 200 animal entries participated in the youth show on Monday.
